The Royal Lymington Yacht Club's second and third RIBAX RAIDs are being planned for mid-week in June or early July. It is expected there may be 10 boats for each Raid and a maximum of 50 people on each RAID.

One Raid to go West with a target of Lulworth or Poole Harbour. One Raid to go East to Chichester Harbour or Portsmouth Harbour A back up raid inside the Solent will be planned for inclement weather. The RAIDs will take place in June or early July mid-week. Possible dates: May 26th-29th, June 9th-12th, June 23rd-26th and July 7th-10th.

A RAID is not a race. The object of the day is to explore the coastline, inlets and anchorages in company. The pace will be agreed by participants to suit the conditions.

The day will start with a briefing in the Club by Nick Ryley, the event organizer at 08.00.
